

Copy any lesson link and share it with students, parents and colleagues however you choose.







Sharing using Quick Codes


Share the Quick Code ("LZ3080 in this example) with students, colleagues or parents.





Step 1: Set up your class

Then create your class



Sharing with classes and assignments

Step 2: Help your students log in and join your class

Ask your students to click on “Student log in” on your homepage. They can then log in using their username and password.

IMPORTANT: Student accounts must be created by your school or district administrators. Please contact an administrator if you are unsure of your students' usernames and passwords.




Sharing with classes and assignments

Step 2: Help your students log in and join your class

After logging in, students click “add class”




In order to join your class, students then enter the unique enrollment code that was assigned to them when you added them to your class.

Step 3: Assign video lessons and quizzes



To assign a video lesson or quiz, return to “my classes” and choose “assignments” from the menu.


Sharing with classes and assignments

Step 3: Assign video lessons and quizzes

Click on “new assignment”




Preview or select the playlist or quiz you’d like to assign. A playlist is a set of video lessons on a specific standard. You can assign any playlist for math or ELA for grades 2-12. Quizzes are currently available for math for grades 3-8.

Step 3: Assign video lessons and quizzes


As students complete their quizzes and assignments, check back to see their progress and results
